# **Payment**

- \* \$79 per credit hour. You will receive a bill directly from SATC
- \* 3 credit hours or less must be paid in full by the first day of class
- \* More than 3 credit hours qualify for a payment plan of 4 equal payments
- \* Jeffcoat Scholarship if you are on free/reduced lunches, talk to your AHS counselor about local tuition assistance. The Jeffcoat Scholarship application must be turned in with your application by May 13th!
